Academic Innovation > Extend guided pathways, expand summer/winter options, incorporate microcredentialing, access qualified faculty, expand upper-level electives, tap into specialized content, and stay nimble and adaptable.



Efficiency & Quality > Redirect independent studies and teach outs, optimize scheduling and remove bottlenecks, create transfer-friendly policies, and plan for faculty contingencies.





The World Health Organization estimates a projected **shortfall of 10 million healthcare workers** by 2030.

30% of current U.S. job openings in major metropolitan areas are in STEM fields, however, only 11% of the U.S. population has a degree in STEM.





Hanover Research 2023



68% of adults considering enrollment in a higher education program **now prefer non-degree pathways.**



76% of employers surveyed are **more likely to hire** a candidate who has **earned a professional certificate.**



It's estimated that **39 million adults** have completed some college but **left without a degree or credential**, as of July 2020.



4.8% increase in enrollment in **undergraduate non-degree credentials** between spring 2022 and 2023.
