

NetVUE Grant Opportunities

building capacity for cross-campus vocational programming

Professional Development Awards

Length: 1 year

Amount: Up to **\$20,000** (A special initiative allows proposals up to \$25,000)

Deadline: Spring

Purpose: Develop campus conversations about vocation and deepen the capacity of leaders to support students in vocational exploration, enhancing the knowledge, skills, and expertise of faculty and staff vital to undergraduate vocational initiatives.



Program Development Grants

Length: 2 years

Amount: Up to **\$100,000**

Deadline: Early Fall

Purpose: Deepen or strengthen programs already underway (including those from recently completed NetVUE Professional Development Awards). Examples: (a) mini grants for released time to design courses incorporating vocational reflection; (b) programming supporting faculty members and staff for advising, mentoring, and experiential learning; and (c) projects integrating calling and discernment into general education or major/minor requirements.

Vocation Across the Academy Grant

Length: 3 years

Amount: Up to **\$130,000** (plus a donor match. A special “community partnerships” initiative allows proposals up to \$75,000.)

Deadline: Spring

Purpose: Expand vocational exploration programs across the curriculum and co-curricular programs, with goals of: (a) helping students link life philosophy and career preparation; (b) including more faculty members and students in vocational exploration; and (c) building connections with community partners.

supporting individual scholarship and special vocational initiatives



Grants to Individuals for Vocational Exploration

Length: Semester, summer, or one academic year

Amount: \$5,000 to \$25,000

Deadline: October and March

Purpose: Supports innovative projects in scholarship, pedagogy, leadership, and practice of vocation in undergraduate education. Proposals are welcome from new and established scholars and practitioners, especially projects making vocational exploration available to all students and inviting fresh considerations of vocation as a lens for undergraduate education.

Grants for Fostering Leadership in Communities of Faith

Length: 2 years

Amount: Up to \$60,000

Deadline: Late Fall

Purpose: Develops or strengthens programs supporting students considering leadership vocations for faith communities. Programming should develop students' leadership capacity by facilitating connections between students and local faith communities.




Grants for Reframing the Institutional Saga

Length: 3 years

Amount: Up to \$60,000

Deadline: Late Summer

Purpose: Supports the re-examination of an institution's commitments, history, identity, and heritage with attention to present circumstances, enabling them to articulate ties between their past and current vocations. Recipients will create enduring products such as a book, campus exhibit with catalogue, or other durable record of campus conversations and critical thinking.



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
